WINEMAKING

The 2009 vintage of Antigal ONE Doña Angeles Vineyard is a limited-edition Malbec 87 % and 13 % Cabernet Franc presented in an individually numbered bottle. Sun-drenched days and chilly nights in Antigal's finest and highest-laying vineyard allowed the Malbec grapes used for this wine to ripen slowly, intensifying color and aromas. Minimal handling and cold temperature winemaking at our winery protect the integrity of the fruit.

TASTING NOTES

“The finished wine captivates the eye with an intense and deep color. Nose includes hints of plums, blackberries, cherries, spices and white pepper, roasted sweet pepper, dried tomatoes and mint as well. Very good wood with hints of chocolate, cinnamon and coffee can be detected through a long finish. The palate is round and concentrated. Good tannins, firm and silky.”
