WINEMAKING

The 2008 vintage of Antigal ONE La Dolores Vineyard is a limited-edition Malbec presented in an individually numbered bottle. Sun-drenched days and chilly nights in Antigal's finest and highest-laying vineyard allowed the Malbec grapes used for this wine to ripen slowly, intensifying color and aromas. Minimal handling and cold temperature winemaking at our winery protect the integrity of the fruit.

TASTING NOTES

"The finished wine has bright color, very intense and deep, purplish red with blue tones. The aromas are very fresh and notes of maraschino cherries, vanilla, chocolate, cocoa and coconut are provided by wood, exotic black fruits and some field herbs like thyme. The palate is very balanced with good structure and volume, firm and silky tannins."
