WINEMAKING:

Sun-drenched days and chilly nights in Antigal's finest and highest-lying vineyard allowed the Malbec grapes used for this limited-edition wine to ripen slowly, intensifying color and aromas. Minimal handling and cold temperature winemaking at our winery protected the integrity of the fruit. After 22 months' aging in (mainly French) oak, the 2007 vintage of Antigal ONE La Dolores Vineyard was transferred to individually numbered bottles inscribed with the proprietor's signature.

TASTING NOTES:

This single-vineyard wine captivates the eye with an intense ruby color and excites the palate with forward plum and dark cherry aromas. Sweet, firm tannins provide structural integrity while hints of vanilla, graphite and smoke underscore the wine's complexity. The finish is balanced and long.
