WINEMAKING:

Hand-harvested grapes from heavily pruned vines in one of Antigal's high-altitude Uco Valley vineyards were immediately chilled and double-sorted on arrival at the winery. The facility's gravity-fed technology allowed for ultra-gentle winemaking that protected the fruit's true varietal character and well balanced acidity.

TASTING NOTES:

Antigal UNO Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 attracts the eye with its beautiful color: a deep ruby with flashes of black. The wine's cherry-dominant red fruit flavors are underscored with notes of white pepper, tobacco, and cocoa. Tannins are robust yet smoothly rounded, and the finish long. This wine will age well but can be enjoyed now with roasted or grilled meats.
